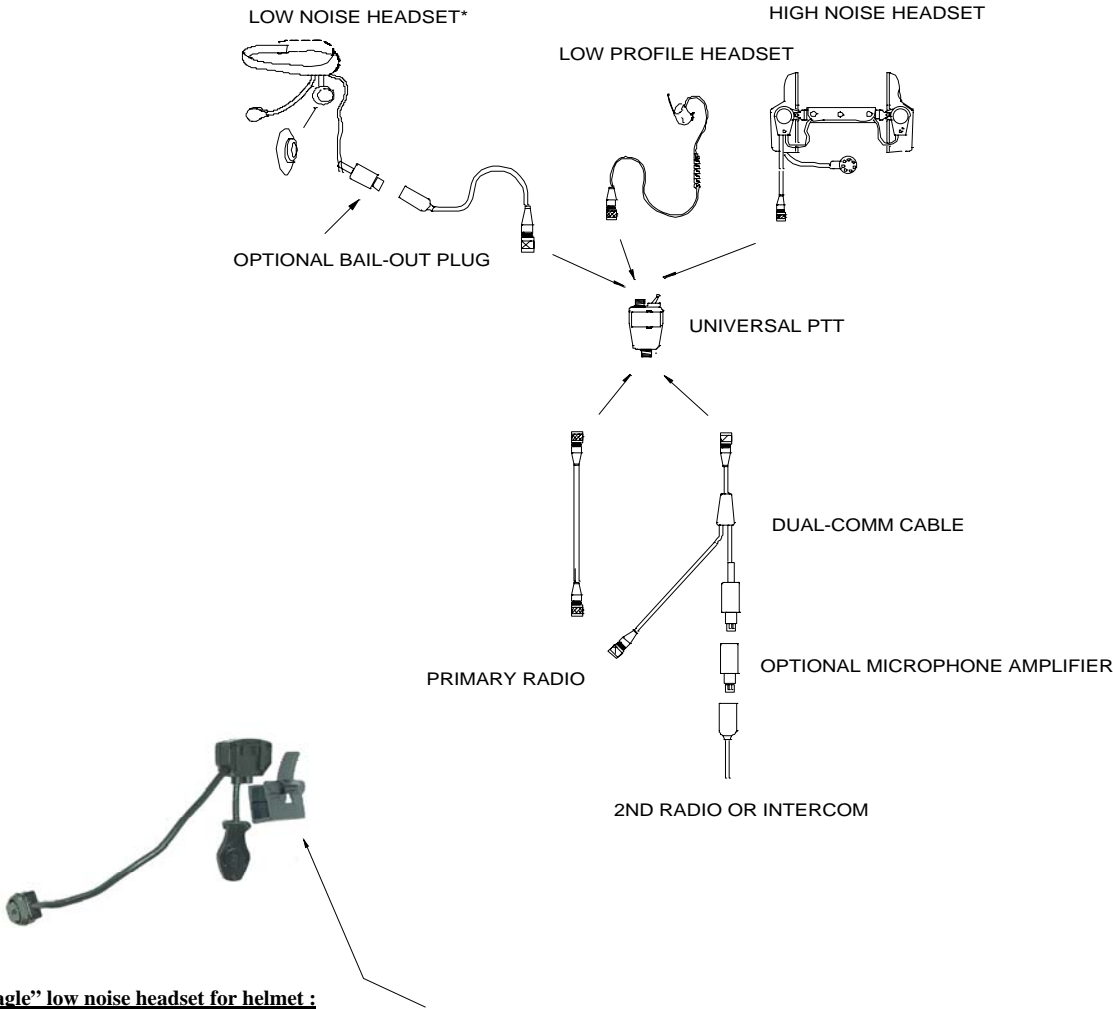

MODULAR INTEGRATED COMMUNICATION HELMET

Instructions

GENERAL FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION. The MICH-M is compatible with a wide variety of radio and intercom platforms and mission profiles when configured with the correct combination of components. The following section describes the HEADSET types, Push-to-talk switches (PTT), and CABLES that are available to enable your mission requirements.



“Eagle” low noise headset for helmet :

- * Remove the headband and slide the helmet-hanger on the connection box when its open side is on top.
- * Slide it on the left side of the helmet and close the lid.
- * Attach to the helmet in such a place so that the earphone should come close to your ear.
- * The boom mic. must as usual be placed in front and as close as possible to your mouth.

“Eagle” For use with a headband : * Disconnect the helmet hanger from the headset.

- *Place the connection box into the headband’s pocket. The Velcro strips must be on the external side of the headband and the earphone and microphone must face the inner parts of the headband.
- Open the upper part of the headband and place the headband on your head so that the headband’s pocket is upon your left ear side.
- The earphone will be placed close to your ear. The boom mic. will face your mouth as close as possible.
- The rubber flange slips over the earpiece for use in high noise or to reduce sound from leaking out in stealth operations.
